If the public can access the high-piled storage areas an Evacuation Plan shall be required to be provided to the fire code official for review. A separate set of plans showing location, width of aisles, location of exits, exit access

doors, exit signs, height of storage and location of hazardous materials shall be provided at the time of permit application for review by fire code official. Once approved, a copy of this plan shall be maintained on the premises in a location approved by the fire code official.
17. A copy of approved septic as-built drawing, if applicable
18. A copy of contractor's registration or Owner Affidavit
19. A City of Black Diamond Business License, if applicable
20. Application fee
