## These household wastes: No paint of any kind

No furniture/household goods No construction/demolition debris No garbage No plastic toys, hoses, etc. No window glass These hazardous wastes:

NO MOTOR OIL. FILTERS, AND ANTIFREEZE No oil based paint or solvents

No pesticides/herbicides No household chemicals No cleaning products No fluorescent lights

Household hazardous wastes (but not latex paint) can be taken to the Auburn Wastemobile at the Outlet Collection Mall (next to Nordstrom Rack) every Saturday and Sunday from 10 am to 5 pm (except major holidays). There is a limit of 25 gallons of gasoline and other automotive fluids per trip. Containers must be five gallons in size or smaller. Customers can have gas containers back upon request. Separate motor (crankcase) oil from all other fluids. Pure crankcase oil containers will be returned. No latex paint is accepted. See www.paintcare.org/wa for more information on paint collection.

Residents may drop off TVs, computer monitors, desktop and laptop computers, tablets, e-readers, and portable DVD players at no charge at the following locations: Goodwill Maple Valley Store (27077 MV Black Diamond RD SE, 253-433-1566), Enumclaw Recyclers (2032 Garrett Street, STE A, Enumclaw, WA 98022, 253-218-9248). CALL FIRST TO CONFIRM HOURS AND IF LOCATIONS ARE OPEN. Drop off locations and conditions may change. Quantities accepted are limited. Computer peripherals such as keyboards, mice, and printers are not included in this program but will be accepted at City Recycling Collection Events. Beware, it is always a good idea to delete or remove all personal information from any item you are recycling - better safe than sorry.



King County



- TIRES: Limit 6 passenger tires per vehicle (18 inches and below) free of charge. \$1.50 for extra tires off rim. \$3.00 for all passenger tires on rims. \$9 charged for each large truck tire and \$18 charged for each truck tire on rim (cash only). No oversized tires accepted.
- LEAD ACID BATTERIES: Car. truck. marine. motorcycle. and sealed lead acid batteries accepted.
- ALKALINE BATTERIES: AAAA, AAA, AA, A, B, C, and D cell alkaline batteries. No rechargeable or nicad batteries. Lithium-ion batteries, like tool and vape batteries, will not be accepted. Visit CallZRecycle.org for more battery recycling options.
- · CONFIDENTIAL PAPER SHREDDING: Shredding and recycling of confidential paper. Limit 4 file-size boxes per household. No exceptions.
- · CARDBOARD: Please flatten. No wax coated cardboard.
- PORCELAIN TOILETS AND SINKS: \$15 charge (cash only). Toilet seats, hardware, and base wax rings must be removed.
- PROPANE TANKS: Residential 5-gallon tanks only. \$5 charge (cash only).
- BULKY WOOD: Includes tree branches (minimum 6 inches in diameter), logs, clean wood, plywood, pallets, and other untreated and unpainted wood. No leaves, grass, small branches, sod, or brush. Please lay a tarp under material for ease of removal.
- · APPLIANCES AND SCRAP METAL: Auto parts, engines and gas lawnmowers (drained of oil and gasoline), appliances, metal lawn chairs, stoves, microwaves, washers & dryers, dishwashers, barbecues, iron, steel, aluminum, brass, copper, and other ferrous and nonferrous metals. \$5 will be charged for each water heater that still has insulation coating (cash only). Metals that are insulated, rubber or oil coated, previously or currently contain gas, oil, chemicals, paint, or hazardous materials will not be accepted. Light fixture ballasts, and sealed drums will not be accepted.
- REFRIGERATORS AND FREEZERS: \$35 (cash only) will be charged for each refrigerator or freezer. \$35 (cash only) will be charged for each household air conditioner.
- MATTRESSES/BOX SPRINGS: Mattresses and box springs, any size. \$30 per mattress and \$30 per box spring (cash only). Vendor reserves the right to refuse any item it cannot recycle. No furniture or frames. No wet or soiled items.
- ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT: DVD players, VCRs, stereo equipment, printers, copiers, fax machines, scanners, cellular phones/ batteries (remove personal information), and computer peripherals such as keyboards and mice. Computer monitors and televisions will not be accepted. You can recycle these items for free at other locations - see the E-Cycle box below for more information.

# Please provide exact change for user fees.

PLEASE NOTE: MOTOR OIL, FILTERS, AND ANTIFREEZE will not be accepted. Please bring these materials to the roving Household Hazardous Wastemobile or the household hazardous waste collection site in Auburn (Outlet Collection Mall) every Saturday and Sunday from 10 am to 5 pm (except major holidays). Volume restrictions apply. Please segregate motor oil from all other fluids. No latex paint is accepted. See www.paintcare.org/wa for more information on paint collection.

### Rain Barrel, Compost, and Worm Bin Sale Saturday - June 17, 2023 starting at 9 am All items \$25 each. Cash only. While supplies last. No pre or post event sales.

To encourage the use of recycled content material and more efficient use of water, the City is offering recycled plastic rain barrels at a huge discount. In addition, start backyard composting with a compost bin to save resources and money. Composting is a natural process that turns yard waste into rich soil. Yard waste contains mostly water. Once the material decomposes, rich soil is all that's left.





Worm bin composting is an efficient way to convert kitchen scraps into nutrient-rich compost for your garden. Simple to assemble and can be stored inside or out. Made in the US and constructed from high quality recycled plastic-\$25 each.



No yard debris chipping service provided. No flat beds or dump trucks allowed. We reserve the right to refuse oversized, commercial, contaminated, excessive or unacceptable loads.
